

Aethelgard Operational Manual: The Path of the Bonded Navigator

1. The Divergent Mandate: Philosophy of Flight

2. Anatomy of the Aethelgard

The Aethelgard is a 180-meter manifestation of the Violet Echoes' dual-layer philosophy. It possesses the functional grit of a rain-lit skyline and the structural integrity of heartwood. 3. Care of the Organic Bio-Tech Hull

The Aethelgard's hull is not a shell; it is a metabolism. It requires a steward who understands that **Energy is a first-class constraint**.

- **Baseline Health Indicator:** The primary indicator of hull stability is the rhythmic **"thump-thump-thump"** pulse felt through the floorplates. This is the ship's heartwood frequency. A steady, low-frequency resonance indicates high coherence; any shift toward erratic, high-pitched "chatter" indicates systemic distress.

- **Nutritional Protocol:** The Navigator must manage the vessel's metabolic load by harvesting gravitational variance via the ring. Avoid "peak spikes" in energy demand. - **Non-Organic Signal Boosters:** External hardware that bypasses the ship's natural sensory "nerves" will lead to rapid tissue rejection.
- **Pure Control Commands:** Forced hard-code overrides that ignore the ship's biological recommendations cause immediate "attenuation" of the pilot-vessel bond, rendering the ship unresponsive and "cold."

4. Calibration of the Grav Engine Ring

Operating the aft-mounted Grav Engine Ring is an exercise in weighing "sustainable cost" against "technical possibility." Every adjustment to gravitational shear must be calculated through the lens of long-term coherence. **Calibration Procedure:** Calibration requires the Navigator to synchronize the engine's rotational harmonics with the hull's current metabolic state. 5. The Ritual of Mutual Selection (The Soul-Bond)
